The Pulitzer Prizes



The 2016 Pulitzer Prize winners for excellence in literature, journalism, music, and photography — the 100th set since awards were first handed out in 1917 — were awarded last month. Winners in Letters and Drama include:

- Fiction – Viet Thahn Nguyen for *The Sympathizer*
- History – T.J. Stiles for *Custer's Trials: A Life on the Frontier of a New America*
- Biography/Autobiography – William Finnegan for *Barbarian Days: A Surfing Life*
- Poetry – Peter Balakian for *Ozone Journal*
- General Non-Fiction – Joby Warrick for *Black Flags: The Rise of ISIS*

SUMMER MOVIES BEGIN JUNE 6TH






CALL TO ARTISTS NEW DATE, NEW LOCATION
