
FRIENDS DONATE MONEY FOR THE PURCHASE OF NEW TRAVEL BOOKS



Summer Reading Program is free and open to all age groups. Pre-registration is strongly recommended for incentives, including books, notebooks, book bags, and is required for all field trips. The 2016 program, "Read Our Town", will offer classes, in the library and field projects, taking the reading into the city parks and environs. Classes include photography, plein air painting, dramatic theater, poetry, horticulture, and physical sciences. All projects will be documented and digitally recorded to create several end projects, including an art and photography show at the library, and a chapbook. Registration forms are available at the library, City Hall, and online at bisbeeaz.gov. Classes are limited. Additional bus services and support will be provided by the City of Bisbee.
