

BLACK HISTORY MONTH LOCAL MUSIC CDs WANTED

In honor of Black History Month, the Copper Queen Library and the Bisbee Royale will be showing Spike Lee's *Chi-Raq*, a modern-day adaptation of the ancient Greek play *Lysistrata* by Aristophanes. After the murder of a child by a stray bullet, a group of women led by Lysistrata organize against the on-going violence in Chicago's Southside creating a movement that challenges the nature of race, sex and violence in America and around the world. Showtime will be on Wednesday, February 15 at the Bisbee Royale. Doors open at 5:00 PM and the film will start at 6:00 PM. Reserve your free ticket at eventbrite.com.
