ROYALE MOVIE : THE PUBLIC WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 14



In "The Public" an unusually bitter Arctic blast has made its way to downtown Cincinnati and the front doors of the public library where the action of the film takes place. At odds with library officials over how to handle the extreme weather event, some homeless patrons turn the building into a shelter for the night by staging an "Occupy" sit in. What begins as an act of civil disobedience becomes a stand-off with police and a rush-to-judgment media constantly speculating about what's really happening. This David versus Goliath story tackles some of our nation's most challenging issues, homelessness and mental illness and sets the drama inside one of the last bastions of democracy-in-action: your public library. pronunciator: NEW LANGUAGE DATABASE

Thanks to the Arizona State Library, patrons of the Copper Queen Library have a new way to learn a new language online. Pronunciator was designed by language teachers over 10 years and offers 100 languages to learn and 68 languages to learn them in. Learners can create language courses that match your personal interests, occupation, learning goals, skill level, age, schedule and motivation. Pronunciator also offers courses in American Sign Language (ASL) with over 20,000 instructional videos and English as a Second Language (ESL).
