### FOOD FOR FINES

The Copper Queen Library will partner with the Bisbee Fire Department again this year to help collect food to distribute to those in need for the December holidays. All month long, library patrons are encouraged to pay off their overdue fines with cans of food (and other non-perishable food items). Each food item donated will count as \$1.00 toward your overdue fines. There will be no change given and food items cannot be used to pay off lost or damaged library materials. Library patrons are encouraged to donate food even if they don't have fines. Feel free to drop off items at the library circulation desk.

In conjunction with the Food Drive, the Library also wraps age-appropriate books as gifts for those families with children receiving Food and Gift Boxes from the Fire Department. Patrons can donate new books or help wrap them at our annual "rap" party which is held at the San Jose Annex mid-December.
