The proposed amendment would amend Bisbee Zoning Code Article 7; Section 7.2.6 “General Requirements Applicable to All Signs” by adding “H” to the General Requirements Applicable to All Signs.

7.2.6 General Requirements Applicable to All Signs

- H. **No sign shall be erected, installed, or maintained at or near any street, intersection, or any location where, by reason of its position, shape, color, or illumination, may interfere with, obstruct the view of, or be confused with any authorized traffic-sign, signal, or traffic regulating device such as traffic cones, or makes use of the word “no parking” or any other word, phrase, symbol, or character in such manner as to interfere with, mislead, or confuse drivers, riders, or pedestrians.**

Should the Planning and Zoning Commission recommend approval of this text amendment to the Mayor and City Council, the City Council will hold a Public Hearing regarding this text amendment on January 2, 2024 after 7PM at the City of Bisbee Council Chambers located at 915 S. Tovreaville Road, Bisbee, Arizona at which time the public is invited to comment regarding this text amendment to Article 7; Section 7.2.6 “General Requirements Applicable to All Signs” by adding “H” to the General Requirements Applicable to All Signs.
