1. Discussion and possible approval of the Minutes (Action Agenda) of the meeting of the Police and Fire Advisory Committee (PFAC) held on September 11, 2024.
2. Review of ADOT Blue Envelope Program.
 - a. Police Department officers are aware of the program and are in the process of getting materials for distribution and availability in Bisbee.
3. Discussion and follow up on Plan for Homeless.
 - a. As this topic relates to the Police and Fire Advisory Committee, the Police Department responds to calls and enforces the law. Policy or Plan regarding Homeless issues would come from the City and is not the responsibility of the Police Department.
 - b. The City works with the Homeless Shelter and Cochise Harms Reduction in response to public concerns.
 - c. The Fuels Mitigation grant will address the City lot behind Safeway.
4. Discussion on Police Foot Patrol.
 - a. The Police Department does not require or assign foot patrol to officers.
 - b. Individual officers may make the choice to do so.
5. Discussion on Electric Bicycle donation in lieu of foot patrol.
 - a. Electric Bicycles have benefits but is not a practical option at this time.
 - b. Additional staffing and training costs outweigh the advantages.
 - c. The unique, spread-out area of Bisbee makes it difficult to maintain efficient response time.
 - d. Bisbee has had bicycle patrol in the past at points when the department was fully staffed.
