

This book is a collection of original stories for children, about desert animals, tales of lost and found treasures, and many other adventures where



Cooking with what was available in the desert was a way of life in those lean years. Walter learned how to cook "somethin' out of nothin'" at a very young age and was never bashful about making up a new recipe.

He caught rabbit, quail or rattlesnake when there was little else to eat and could make a batch of light bread or corn bread with nothing more than a little flour, cornmeal, honey and water using a wood stove for baking and cooking, after scouring the countryside for wood.
