The Planning and Zoning commission of the City of Bisbee will be holding a public hearing on **Thursday August 17th, 2017 after 5:30 pm** in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 118 Arizona Street, at which time the public is invited to comment, regarding an application for rezoning of the property at 1556 Naco Highway in Bisbee, the former C.C.A.H. facility.

The Applicant is asking that the zoning of these properties be changed from R-1 to C-3. C-3 Zoning will allow the owner to use the property as an office, retail, automobile service station, restaurant, church, recreational & educational facility, small scale retail, personal service that serves the day to day needs of the residents of the surrounding area, nursery, physical fitness center, community & fraternal club, library, governmental office, supermarket, department store, hospital, automotive sale, lumberyard, wholesale outlet, printing plant, cocktail lounge & tavern, self storage center, theatre, bowling alley, museum, hotel & motel.

This property is currently zoned R-1 with a City Special Use Permit allowing a care facility and associated offices.
