A Testimonial by Mary Jane Bank

Having worked in a city library for twenty-some years, I was only too familiar with the public library's role as a haven for the homeless. Our policy was, "Just don't snore too loud and we'll keep you warm in the winter and cool in the summer until the shelter lets you back in for dinner."



Imagine my surprise, then, when I found myself to be in that situation.

It was St. George, Utah. My home was a campsite, my bed the converted back seat of a car, and the thermometer was reading 109 degrees.

The floors of the 100-year-old Carnegie-built library were vibrating that day from the overworked A/C unit. I made my way to an empty wing chair near the 000-100's and pulled out my book. It was five o'clock before I had the courage to return outside.

Webster defines sanctuary as "a place of refuge or safety." That day I defined it "library."

Another library that came to the rescue of this "homeless" person was located in Stanley, Idaho, population 53 or 64, depending on who'd you ask. This library had installed 12 electrical outlets outside on wooden benches providing me with a 24/7 technology lifeline.



Don't plan on a visit, though, unless you can score the slot in their writer-in-residence program. The house, surrounded by woody estates, will continue to be very, very private.


Movies
