
## ASTRONAUT MARK KELLY TO VISIT THE CQ LIBRARY JUNE 27<sup>TH</sup>



Retired Astronaut Mark Kelly will be visiting the Summer Reading Program on **Thursday, June 27<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 PM**. Kelly was selected to become a NASA space shuttle pilot in 1996 and flew his first mission in 2001 as pilot of STS-108. He piloted STS-121 in 2006 and commanded STS-124 in 2008 and STS-134 in 2011. STS-134 was his final mission and the final mission of space shuttle Endeavour. Kelly is also the author of two children book series, *Mousestronaut* and *Astrotwins*. During his time as an astronaut, he traveled over 4.8 million miles and orbited the earth 186 times. He is married to Gabrielle Giffords who served as a U.S. Congresswoman for Arizona from 2007 to 2012.





## Have fun with mAth & SCIENCE WEDNESDAYS | 11:30 - 12:30

This summer, explore math and science concepts with your preschool child in an interactive and playful way with teacher Gretchen Hill. Based on the Arizona Early Learning standards for math and science, this 6-week course will explore concepts and introduce strategies to use with your child to help build and strengthen their mathematical and scientific thinking skills.

- Session 1: Exploration and Our 5 Senses
- Session 2: Counting and Comparing
- Session 3: Geometry and Identifying Attributes
- Session 4: Sorting and Classifying through Investigation
- Session 5: Patterning, Sequencing and Making Observations
- Session 6: Measurement, Hypothesizing and Experimenting

Participants are encouraged to come to all six sessions. Kickoff for Fun with Math and Science will begin on **Wednesday, June 12 at 11:30 am** in the Children's Library.
