



Public Hearing Regarding Use of CDBG Funds

The City of Bisbee anticipates applying for up to \$500,000 in FY2019 federal CDBG funds from the Arizona Department of Housing Colonias Set-Aside account. CDBG funds must be used to benefit low-income persons and areas, alleviate slum and blight or address urgent need. A).
