“UPDATING THE DESIGN GUIDELINES FOR THE BISBEE HISTORIC DISTRICTS”

The current guidelines were adopted in 1991 by Resolution; those guidelines are used by the City of Bisbee Design Review Board and the General Public as a policy stated to assist in the preservation of the Bisbee Historic Districts.

In order to carry out fully the provisions and intent of the Design Review Board, to protect the Historical Districts of Bisbee from detrimental effects of inharmonious elements being introduced to the historical or visual characteristics of the districts.

Proposed Update: **“Development Standards for Bisbee, Arizona Historic District”**

The Design Review Board continues to set the standards for clarity and practicality, making the work of the Board easier, along with the applicants. These new standards provide property owners and the Board with concise information and realistic choices for appropriate rehabilitation and new construction.
